- **THEME** Identify a theme (a message or lesson) that can be taken away from the story. Explain how this theme is shown throughout the story.
- **REVIEW/RECOMMENDATION-** Give the book a rating out of 5 stars (1 star = the worst, 5 stars = the best). Write three bullet points explaining your thoughts on the novel.
